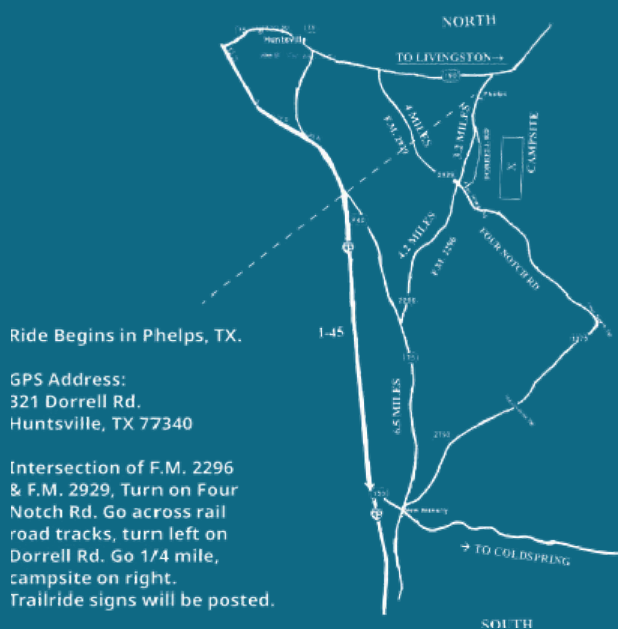
Saturday Night Dinner and Auction
